#### Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- HB 2834 A  
Requires State Department of Fish and Wildlife, in cooperation with Department of Transportation, to develop Wildlife Corridor Action Plan for use by state agencies.
- HB 3035 A  
Increases maximum penalty for certain wildlife law offenses committed without culpable mental state to \$2,000 fine.
- HB 3272 A  
Limits extension that Land Use Board of Appeals may provide petitioner whose objection to record is denied to 14 days from later of original deadline or date of denial.

#### Work Session

- HB 2351 A  
Authorizes State Marine Board to adopt special regulations to protect shoreline in Willamette River Greenway.
- HB 2577 A  
Requires minimum three-year delay of effective date for annexation of property that is zoned to allow residential use as permitted use in zone and is in residential use when annexation is initiated.
- HB 2835 A  
Requires state agencies to post notice on agency website before restricting or closing site on state public lands where public may access lands for recreational use of floatable natural waterway.
- HB 2844 A  
Allows facilities for processing farm products under 2,500 square feet on lands zoned for exclusive farm use without regard to siting standards.
- HB 2914 A  
Removes requirement that certain Metro lands be zoned for employment land of state significance.
- HB 3114 A  
Makes changes to requirements for recycling certain electronic devices.

HB 3168

Authorizes operation of boats propelled by electric motors on named lakes and waters of this state under certain circumstances.

HB 3384 A

Limits reasons counties may deny expansion of certain schools on land zoned for exclusive farm use.
