Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- HB 2085 A
Regulates construction and removal of dams.
- HB 2379 A
Makes legislative findings regarding failure of United States Army Corps of Engineers to operate Cole M. Rivers Hatchery in conformance with fish return goals.
- HB 2435 A
Makes permanent 2018 law sunseting April 15, 2020, that allows guest ranches to be established on lands zoned for exclusive farm use in eastern Oregon.
- HB 2469 A
Allows counties to approve second dwelling on forestlands within rural fire protection district near existing dwelling for owner or relative who supports owner's forestry practices.
- HB 2953 A
Requires State Forestry Department to report biennially to committee of Legislative Assembly regarding outcomes from all projects pursued in state under Good Neighbor Authority Agreement .
- HCR 35
Recognizes 2019 as International Year of the Salmon and expresses support for associated global initiative affirming importance of wild salmon.

Work Session

- HB 2106 A
Allows dog training classes to be conducted in farm buildings existing on January 1, 2019, within counties that adopted marginal lands provisions.
- HB 2790 A
Expands definition of "outdoor mass gathering" to include certain rural gatherings.

HB 3024

Prohibits county from considering property tax classification of dwellings that were previously removed, destroyed, demolished or converted to nonresidential uses when reviewing application for replacement dwelling on lands zoned for exclusive farm use.

Possible Reconsideration and Work Session

HB 3384 A

Limits reasons counties may deny expansion of certain schools on land zoned for exclusive farm use.
