SB 193

Provides that interstate broadcaster's market for sales, used in determination of receipts factor in apportionment formula for corporate excise tax, is in state if customer's corporate domicile is in state or if individual customer is resident of state.

SB 523

Authorizes Department of Revenue to make publicly available by posting online information about delinquent tax debtors.

SB 702 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Directs Legislative Revenue Officer to study land value taxation and submit report to interim legislative committees related to revenue.

SB 162

Provides that personal income taxpayer may establish account in Oregon 529 Savings Network through election on tax return form.
