#### Public Hearing

SB 393 A

Authorizes translator districts to annex cities where cable television corporations operate or have ceased operations and city electors approve annexation.

SB 595

Adjusts allocation percentages of net revenue from new or increased local transient lodging tax to allow up to 30 percent of such revenue to be used to fund affordable workforce housing.

SB 523
