Work Session

SB 165

Directs employer, on annual tax withholding return submitted to Department of Revenue, to indicate whether employer offers qualified retirement savings plan that would allow exemption from participation in Oregon Retirement Savings Plan.

SB 193

Provides that interstate broadcaster's market for sales, used in determination of receipts factor in apportionment formula for corporate excise tax, is in state if customer's corporate domicile is in state or if individual customer is resident of state.

SB 702 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Directs Legislative Revenue Officer to study land value taxation and submit report to interim legislative committees related to revenue.

SB 769

Provides that request for computation of fee in lieu of property taxes for property constituting solar project may not be filed after April 1 immediately preceding property tax year to which request relates.

SB 393 A

Authorizes translator districts to annex cities where cable television corporations operate or have ceased operations and city electors approve annexation.

SB 262

Extends sunset for property tax exemption for multiple-unit housing.
