- SB 889  
Establishes Health Care Cost Growth Benchmark program to control growth of health care expenditures in this state.
- SB 841 \*\*  
Requires Oregon Health Authority to compile health care expenditure report concerning expenditures related to medical assistance, Medicare, commercial insurance and self-insurance. \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
- SB 900 \*\*  
Imposes requirements on outpatient dialysis treatment facility, or entity that has financial interest in outpatient dialysis treatment facility, that pays health insurance premiums for patients of outpatient dialysis treatment facility. \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
- SB 137  
Prohibits coordinated care organization from contracting with any entity to assume risk of providing behavioral health services or to assume responsibility for utilization management, care coordination, denials of service, grievances or appeals.

#### Work Session

- SB 138  
Reestablishes Mental Health Clinical Advisory Group in Oregon Health Authority to continue development of evidence-based algorithms for prescription drug treatment of mental health disorders.
