Public Hearing

- SB 331
Requires local governments conducting buildable lands review within urban growth boundary to consider impacts on various income levels, to analyze housing price ranges and to consider gentrification.
- SB 334
Requires city to expand its urban growth boundary to include land designated as urban reserve that supports workforce housing and commercial development supportive of workforce housing if urban services are or can be made available.
- SB 534
Requires city to allow single-family dwellings in residential lots platted and zoned for such uses.

Work Session

- SB 197 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Tax Expenditures
Extends sunset for tax credit for closure of manufactured dwelling park.
- SB 484
Limits landlord to single applicant screening charge per applicant applying to rent multiple dwelling units owned or managed by landlord.

- SB 940
Excludes portion of revenue received from federal forest reserves when calculating Local Revenues for purpose of State School Fund distributions.
