Work Session

- SB 491
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 03/12/2019 AGENDA: Transfers from Department of Human Services to Oregon Community Foundation responsibility for administering Fairview housing trust.
- SB 804 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Judiciary then to Ways and Means
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 03/12/2019 AGENDA: Modifies child abuse reporting requirements to require Department of Human Services to notify law enforcement agency within county where alleged child abuse occurred.

Public Hearing

- SB 832 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Declares purpose of Critical Incident Review Teams.

Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- SB 790 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Tax Expenditures
Increases total amount allowed in tax year to all taxpayers as tax credits for donations to fiduciary organizations for distribution to individual development accounts.
- SB 15
Authorizes Youth Development Council to inspect and collect data from facilities in which juveniles are detained to ensure compliance with federal Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Act.
- SB 921 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Judiciary
Modifies child abuse reporting requirements to add hotelkeepers and innkeepers as mandatory reporters of child abuse.
- SB 195 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Tax Expenditures
Prescribes amount of expenses for which tax credit for employment-related dependent care expenses may be claimed by removing limitations based on earned income of individual spouse, in case of joint tax filers.
- SB 964 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Tax Expenditures
Directs Department of Human Services to establish pilot program to encourage innovative strategies to strengthen families and build resilient neighborhoods.

Work Session

- SB 813
Directs Office of Child Care to make reasonable attempt to identify any facility about which it receives complaint if certain information is provided.
- SB 833 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Directs Department of Human Services to require criminal records checks on noninvolved parents prior to releasing child in protective custody to custody of noninvolved parent.
- SB 917 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Prohibits long term care facilities, residential facilities, adult foster homes, child care facilities, child-caring agencies, foster homes, youth care centers, youth offender foster homes or other entities that are licensed, certified or registered to provide care to children, youth, individuals with disabilities or older adults from interfering with disclosure of information by prospective employees, employees or volunteers about treatment of individuals cared for by entity to regulatory agencies, law enforcement authorities or persons acting on behalf of individual.
- SB 727 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Requires Department of Human Services to adopt by rule program that provides financial assistance to recipients of supplemental nutrition assistance for purchasing locally grown fruits and vegetables from participating farmers' markets, farm share sites and retail outlets.
