- SB 790 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Tax Expenditures  
CARRIED OVER FROM 3/14/2019 AGENDA: Increases total amount allowed in tax year to all taxpayers as tax credits for donations to fiduciary organizations for distribution to individual development accounts.
- SB 809 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Judiciary then to Ways and Means  
Requires Department of Human Services and Oregon Health Authority to prescribe by rule criteria for making fitness determinations.
- SB 924 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Judiciary then to Ways and Means  
Modifies juvenile code to prohibit placement of children and wards taken into protective custody in detention facilities.

#### Work Session

- SB 490  
Adds individuals who have operated child care facility in violation of child care facility or Central Background Registry law to list of individuals who are prohibited from providing child care for five years.
