SCR 4

Declares policy of State of Oregon concerning cybersecurity risks and need for proactive cybersecurity risk management.

SB 383

Restricts arbitration award from ordering disciplinary action that differs from disciplinary action imposed by law enforcement agency if arbitrator makes finding of employee misconduct, consistent with agency's finding of misconduct, and disciplinary action imposed by agency was made pursuant to discipline guide incorporated into agency's disciplinary policies.

SB 684

Specifies requirements for covered entities that own, license, maintain, store, manage, collect, process, acquire or otherwise possess personal information, and for vendors that provide services to covered entities, to notify consumers of breach of security.

Repeals crime of unlawfully transporting hay.
