Public Hearing

- SB 318
Creates rebuttable presumption that equal parenting time is in best interests of child.
- SB 356
Permits detailed parenting plan to include instructions regarding notification requirements for specified matters.
- SB 371
Establishes pilot programs for purpose of appointing legal counsel for children in contested domestic relations proceedings.
- SB 385 **
Directs presiding judge of each judicial district to establish alternative dispute resolution conference procedure for custody and parenting time modifications and enforcement proceedings. **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
- SB 736
Modifies terminology in domestic relations proceedings regarding custody of and parenting time with children.
