Public Hearing and Work Session

- SB 24
Modifies procedures related to criminal defendants lacking fitness to proceed.
- SB 378
Requires that court-ordered fitness to proceed examination and filing of examination report occur within 14 days of examination order if defendant is in custody.

Work Session

- SB 25
Directs public bodies, and private entities in possession of relevant records, to comply, within specified time period, with court order for release of records to state mental hospital or other facility for purposes of forensic evaluation.
- SB 488
Requires Department of Corrections and local correctional facilities to offer immunization against influenza virus to each inmate and prisoner.
- SB 495
Prohibits use of dogs in correctional facilities for other than specified purposes.
