Public Hearing

- SB 35 A
Exempts Department of Veterans' Affairs from requirement to include vouchers for disbursements with conservator's accounting to court.
- SB 762
Extends date by which commitment hearing must be held.
- SB 810
Modifies definition of "vulnerable user of a public way" to include persons operating or riding on moped or motorcycle.
- SB 912 **
Revises definition of terms "sexual conduct" and "substantiated report" for purposes of certain laws related to abuse and sexual conduct by school employees. **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
- SB 1016
Provides exception from offense of driving motor vehicle while using mobile electronic device for person operating school bus, if person is using communication device designed for school bus dispatch communication.
