SB 1013

Removes future dangerousness as factor for jury to determine when deciding on sentence of death.

Work Session

SB 383

Restricts arbitration award from ordering disciplinary action that differs from disciplinary action imposed by law enforcement agency if arbitrator makes finding of employee misconduct, consistent with agency's finding of misconduct, and disciplinary action imposed by agency was made pursuant to discipline guide incorporated into agency's disciplinary policies.

SB 437

Modifies provisions relating to arbitration award that orders reinstatement of public employee or otherwise relieves public employee of responsibility for misconduct.

SB 581

Increases criminal penalties for offense relating to use of unmanned aircraft system to interfere with aircraft.

SB 858

Allows any county governing body to enter into intergovernmental agreement with Judicial Department to provide law library services or enter into contract with law library association or corporation owning and maintaining law library convenient to courthouse for use by legal community.

SB 891

Requires that court hold hearing on petition to appoint fiduciary filed by Oregon Public Guardian and Conservator or county public guardian and conservator.

SB 962 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means Directs certifying agencies to certify to United States Citizenship and Immigration Services, within specified time, victim helpfulness in detecting, investigating or prosecuting qualifying criminal activity.
