#### Public Hearing and Work Session

- SB 759  
Provides that auction company has lien on motor vehicle that auction company possesses and stored on premises that auction company owns or controls.
- SB 797  
Provides exception to offense of illegal consignment practices.
- SB 965  
Expands offense of driving while under influence of intoxicants to include any drug that is used in combination with intoxicating liquor, inhalant, cannabis or controlled substance.
- SB 999  
Deletes obsolete reference to definition of "alternative fuel vehicle." Defines "alternative fuel vehicle."
- HB 2913  
Removes requirement for person to have surety bond in effect before making, altering, repairing, transporting, storing, providing services for, supplying materials for or performing labor in connection with motor vehicle.

#### Work Session

- SB 11  
Prohibits transferring right to redeem property to successor in interest by sale.
- SB 35 A  
Exempts Department of Veterans' Affairs from requirement to include vouchers for disbursements with conservator's accounting to court.
- SB 113  
Authorizes court to award prevailing retail customers, who bring actions against vehicle dealers, attorney fees under certain circumstances.
- SB 279  
Requires certain persons that service student loans in this state to obtain or renew license.
- SB 379  
Provides that conditioning employment on refraining from using any substance that is lawful to use in this state is unlawful employment practice.

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**AGENDA (Cont.)**  
**April 3, 2019**

- SB 548  
Directs Department of Justice to study issues related to consumer protection and towing and to provide results of study to Legislative Assembly no later than December 31, 2019.
- SB 576  
Imposes certain requirements related to private security providers who contract with institutions of higher education to provide private security services on campus and special campus security officers commissioned by governing boards of public universities.
- SB 582  
Authorizes Governor to enter into agreement with another state for purpose of cross-jurisdictional coordination and enforcement of marijuana-related businesses.
- SB 723  
Prohibits person from organizing, sponsoring, promoting, conducting or participating in contest, competition, tournament or derby that has objective of taking wildlife for prizes or other inducement or for entertainment.
- SB 775  
Requires public bodies to use Department of State Police for purposes of requesting criminal records checks relating to employment by public body.
