Public Hearing and Work Session

- HB 2051 A
Conditionally exempts from disclosure, pursuant to public records request, contents of reports made through Department of State Police statewide tip line unless public interest requires disclosure in particular instance.
- HB 2286
Places civil forfeiture proceeds used to fund scholarship for children of deceased or disabled public safety officers in account established or designated by State Treasurer in Oregon 529 Savings Network, rather than in Oregon 529 College Savings Plan Subaccount.
- HB 2466 A
Requires certain homeowners associations and all condominium unit owners associations to carry fidelity bond coverage, unless owners and board have elected otherwise in the preceeding year.
- HB 2485 A
Establishes procedures for adoption of restated declaration, restated assignment of use of limited common elements and restated bylaws by condominium association.
