## **Public Hearing and Work Session**

HB 2240

Authorizes State Court Administrator to establish Central Violations Bureau and designate employees to act as violations clerks.

HB 2462 A

Directs court to, at time of arraignment, notify defendant that status as servicemember may make defendant eligible for treatment programs, diversion, specialty courts or sentencing mitigation.

HB 2585 A

Directs Chief Medical Examiner to complete and file report of death for person within 45 days after receiving report from Search and Rescue Coordinator, in conjunction with county sheriff, that person is missing in wilderness and presumed dead.

HB 2589 A

Clarifies that sexual orientation is not considered physical or mental impairment and that individual does not have disability solely by reason of individual's sexual orientation.
