HB 2932

Prohibits court from inquiring into defendant's immigration status or requiring defendant to disclose defendant's immigration status at time of plea or at any other time during criminal proceeding.

HB 2480 A

Provides that statement purporting to interpret otherwise admissible statement from one language into another does not constitute hearsay if declarant testifies.

HB 3117 A

Modifies Farmily Abuse Prevention Act to authorize court to continue restraining order if abuse occurred within specified period, petitioner reasonably fears for petitioner's physical safety and respondent represents credible threat to physical safety of petitioner or petitioner's child.

HB 2425

Allows county clerk to record electronic record or record bearing electronic signature.
