#### Public Hearing and Work Session

HB 2375 A

Requires district attorney to include sexual assault nurse examiner or hospital representative in sexual assault response team organized by district attorney to adopt protocols addressing response to sexual assault victims.

HB 2395 A

Requires manufacturer to equip connected device with reasonable security features that protect connected device and information that connected device stores from access, destruction, modification, use or disclosure that consumer does not authorize.

HB 3005 A

Modifies laws related to ignition interlock devices.
