#### Public Hearing and Work Session

HB 2459 A

Permits person or agent of person that holds lien that encumbers real property to request statement from person that holds another lien that also encumbers same real property of amount that is necessary to pay off other lien.

HB 2598 A

Permits creation of certain noncharitable business purpose trusts.

HB 3006

Modifies procedures for probate of estate with no known assets.

HB 3007 A

Modifies provisions relating to small estates.

HB 3008 A

Requires approval by probate court of settlement of personal injury claim or wrongful death claim arising out of injuries to decedent.

#### Work Session

HB 2051 A

Conditionally exempts from disclosure, pursuant to public records request, contents of reports made through Department of State Police statewide tip line unless public interest requires disclosure in particular instance.

HB 2425

Allows county clerk to record electronic record or record bearing electronic signature.
