Public Hearing and Work Session

- HB 2285 A
Clarifies receivership proceedings and reporting and notice requirements for residential properties that city or county determines are threat to public health, safety or welfare.
- HB 2227
Modifies list of mandatory reporters of suspected child abuse to include animal control officers.
- HB 2474 A
Excludes subpoenas issued by district attorneys for grand juries, or by Attorney General, from certain notice, content and procedural requirements applicable to summonses and subpoenas issued to financial institutions for financial records of customers.
- HB 3117 A
Modifies Family Abuse Prevention Act to authorize court to continue restraining order if abuse occurred within specified period, petitioner reasonably fears for petitioner's physical safety and respondent represents credible threat to physical safety of petitioner or petitioner's child.
