HB 2014

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 5/6/2019 AGENDA: Restricts limitation on award of noneconomic damages to claims in actions for wrongful death.

HB 3289 A

Directs Oregon Criminal Justice Commission to conduct studies on local and regional correctional facility data collection and provision of health care.

HB 3201 A

Provides that agreement for deferred resolution of criminal cases may not contain requirement that defendant enter plea of guilty or no contest.

Work Session

HB 2227

Modifies list of mandatory reporters of suspected child abuse to include animal control officers.

HB 3117 A

Modifies Family Abuse Prevention Act to authorize court to continue restraining order if abuse occurred within specified period, petitioner reasonably fears for petitioner's physical safety and respondent represents credible threat to physical safety of petitioner or petitioner's child.
