#### Public Hearing and Work Session

- HB 2303 A  
Allows pharmacist or pharmacy technician to transfer drug containing pseudoephedrine without prescription to person who is at least 18 years of age and presents person's valid government-issued photo identification.
- HB 3216 A  
Creates civil cause of action against person who knowingly summons police officer for reason other than suspected criminal activity with intent to cause specified harm.
- HB 3224  
Directs district attorney of each county to, no later than December 1, 2020, develop and adopt policies relating to discovery, charging decisions and case disposition and to make policies available to public on website.
- HB 3249 A  
Provides that client has right to privately communicate with lawyer and representative of lawyer.

#### Work Session

- HB 2500 A  
Provides private right of action to recover for expenses in relation to veterinary care for abused domestic animal.
