HB 3415 A

Requires institutions of higher education to both adopt written policies and require certain individuals to participate in annual training on sexual harassment, sexual assault, domestic violence, dating violence and stalking.

HB 2013 A

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 5/15/2019 AGENDA: Provides that person subject to certain court protective orders is prohibited from possessing firearms if person had opportunity to be heard on order and did not request hearing, failed to appear at hearing or withdrew request before hearing occurred.

HB 2079

Modifies and adds laws related to boating offenses.
