Public Hearing and Work Session

HB 3293 A

Provides that action based on sexual assault or knowingly allowing, permitting or encouraging sexual assault that occurs when person is 18 years of age or older must be commenced within seven years from date person discovers, or in exercise of reasonable care should have discovered, causal connection between sexual assault and injury.

HB 2014

Restricts limitation on award of noneconomic damages to claims in actions for wrongful death.

HB 2585 A

Directs Chief Medical Examiner to complete and file report of death for person within 45 days after receiving report from Search and Rescue Coordinator, in conjunction with county sheriff, that person is missing in wilderness and presumed dead.

HB 3415 A
