Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- HB 2491 A
Establishes procedure for participation as write-in candidate for precinct committeeperson.
- SB 594
Requires candidate for President or Vice President of United States, in order to appear on general election ballot or in general election voters' pamphlet, to provide Secretary of State with copy of candidate's federal income tax returns for five years preceding year of general election and with written consent for public disclosure of tax returns.
- SJM 11
Urges Congress to require individual to disclose relevant portions of federal tax return to appear on ballot as candidate for federal elected office.

- HB 2595
Alters period during which former member of Legislative Assembly is prohibited from being paid lobbyist from sine die of next regular session that begins after person ceases to be member to one year after person ceases to be member.
- HCR 2 A
Commemorates 150th anniversary of Abraham Lincoln High School in Portland.
- SCR 30
Designates week of _____, 2019, as Oregon Scenic Bikeways Week.
- SCR 33
Declares that lung cancer is public health priority.

- HB 2236
Allows farm tractors to operate on state highways that have speed limit or posted speed of more than 35 miles per hour.
