Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- HB 3076 A
Requires nonprofit hospitals and their nonprofit affiliated clinics to establish financial assistance policies meeting specified criteria, including reducing charges to low-income patients.
- HB 3022 A
Provides that diagnostic services are compensable under workers' compensation law after industrial accident or occupational disease has been determined to be compensable and if diagnostic services are reasonable and necessary to identify nature or extent of medical condition that may be related to industrial accident or occupational disease.
- HB 3310 A
Prohibits school district, community college district and certain education service district elections from being conducted in manner that impairs ability of members of protected class to have equal opportunity to elect candidates of their choice as result of dilution or abridgment of rights of electors who are members of protected class.
- HCR 30 A
In memoriam: Ricky John Best, 1964-2017.

The following bill is scheduled for the purpose of considering the -2 amendments that replace the measure:

- SB 226
Permits minor political parties to choose to nominate candidates for particular offices as part of state-sponsored primary election.
- SR 2
Recognizes and honors Diane Berry for her service to City of Echo and State of Oregon.
- SJR 18 A
Proposes amendment to Oregon Constitution to permit Legislative Assembly, governing body of city, county, municipality or district, or people through initiative process, to enact laws or ordinances regulating within its jurisdiction use of moneys in political campaigns.
