SB 198 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Tax Expenditures
Extends sunset for tax credit for pension income.

SB 164
Makes employer's failure to comply with requirements of Oregon Retirement Savings Plan unlawful practice.

Work Session

SB 705
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/5/2019 AGENDA: Directs Public Employees Retirement Board to allow participating employers making certain lump sum payments to Public Employees Retirement System to choose starting date for amortization period for use of lump sum payment to offset contributions to system.

SB 75
Provides that interest earned by Employer Incentive Fund may be used to match lump sum payments by participating public employers in Public Employees Retirement System.

SB 203 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Tax Expenditures
Extends sunset for earned income tax credit.

SB 758 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Finance and Revenue
Increases percentage of federal earned income credit allowable as credit against Oregon personal income tax.

SB 243
Requires Department of Veterans' Affairs to conduct study to determine effects of employment discrimination against veterans on overall veteran unemployment rate in this state.

SB 519
Increases minimum wage exemption for purposes of garnishment and execution.

SB 722
Authorizes Director of Employment Department to prescribe rules that provide individual may not be excluded from being deemed unemployed solely because of service performed for employing unit under legal compulsion for which individual has not received pay on individual's regular payday.
