Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- SB 332
In law providing that, if interview is element of hiring process for civil service position, public employer must interview each veteran who meets minimum and special qualifications for position, eliminates requirement that veteran possess transferable skills from military experience or education and eliminates exception for public employer that conducts interview only for selection of candidate from eligibility list.
- SB 123
Extends application of provision prohibiting salary history inquiries to include employment agencies.
- SB 934 **
Expands exemption from limitations on employment of retired members of Public Employees Retirement System employed by certain law enforcement and correctional agencies. **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Work Session

- SB 494 **
Requires employers who are authorized to pay subminimum wages to individuals with disabilities to pay certain wage rates until June 30, 2023. **Subsequent Referral(s) to Human Services
- SB 370
Requires employer to provide notice to employees of upcoming inspection by federal agency of employer's records regarding identity and employment eligibility of employees within 72 hours of employer's receipt of notice of inspection from agency.
- SB 726
Makes unlawful employment practice for employer to request employee to enter agreement that would prevent employee from disclosing or discussing conduct that constitutes unlawful discrimination, including sexual assault.
- SB 479
Requires public employers to adopt policies to prevent workplace harassment.
- SB 478
Prohibits campaign moneys and public moneys from being used to make payments in connection with nondisclosure agreement relating to harassment in workplace.
