SUMMARY

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Water Resources Department to study ground water in this state. Directs department to provide 10-year plan to Legislative Assembly that prioritizes ground water studies. Directs department to report to Legislative Assembly detailing use of appropriated funds.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

- 10 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
- 11 SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
- 12 ation, there is appropriated to the Water Resources Department, for
- 13 the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, out of the General Fund, the
- amount of \$9,000,000 for ground water studies and investigations or the
- 15 gathering and analysis of other ground water data that is needed to
- 16 assess and manage Oregon's ground water resources in the priority
- 17 basins as determined by the department.
 - SECTION 2. Not later than September 15, 2020, and September 15,

1	2021, the Water Resources Department shall submit to the Legislative
2	Assembly, in the manner provided in ORS 192.245, a report detailing
3	how the moneys appropriated under section 1 of this 2019 Act have
4	been spent.
5	SECTION 3. Not later than January 1, 2020, the Water Resources
6	Department shall submit to the Legislative Assembly a 10-year plan
7	that prioritizes ground water studies throughout this state and details
8	any additional legislative investment necessary to implement the
9	studies.
10	SECTION 4. This 2019 Act being necessary for the immediate pres-
11	ervation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is de-
12	clared to exist, and this 2019 Act takes effect on its passage.
