Measure: SB 451

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Measure Description:

Establishes eligibility for renewable energy certificates for facilities that generate electricity from direct combustion of municipal solid waste and became operational before January 1, 1995, if such facilities register with Western Renewable Energy Generation Information System at any time.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Energy (DOE)

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Joint Committee on Carbon Reduction to the Senate desk for reassignment.

The measure directs the Department of Energy (DOE) to certify renewable energy certificates, for qualifying facilities, generating electricity after January 1, 2011.

The measure will likely have an impact on DOE.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the alternate Senate policy committee.
