**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:**

Appropriates \$2 million from General Fund to Oregon Department of Administrative Services for distribution to City of Mosier for construction of joint-use fire hall and community center. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2019.

**ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

**EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:**

No amendment.

**BACKGROUND:**

The City of Mosier is located on the Columbia River in Wasco County. The City is home to 270 households and four businesses. The Mosier Fire District serves roughly 1,400 Oregonians in 22 square miles, including seven miles of Interstate 84.

The Mosier Community Center Project is a joint effort by the City of Mosier and the Mosier Fire District to develop a shared structure that will house local government and emergency services. Senate Bill 513 appropriates \$2 million for the construction of the structure.
