## WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Increases the value of forest products offered for sale by the Parks and Recreation Commission that require competitive bid process from \$15,000 to \$25,000.

## **ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

# **EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:**

No amendment.

#### **BACKGROUND:**

ORS 390.121 requires the Oregon Parks and Recreation Department (OPRD) to appraise forest products before offering the products for sale. If the appraisal exceeds \$15,000, the Department is required to use a competitive bid process.

Senate Bill 50 would increase the value of forest product sales by OPRD requiring a competitive bid process from \$15,000 to \$25,000.
