# SB 36 STAFF MEASURE SUMMARY

## Senate Committee On Veterans and Emergency Preparedness

### WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Refines and updates Oregon Department of Veterans' Affairs authority to engage in administration of residential home loans for veterans. Modifies purpose of such loans - to acquire homes and farms - by removing references to improvements. Updates definition of "home" to include manufactured homes and condominiums and removes references to mobile homes and houseboats. Conforms to federal bond and lending requirements.

#### **ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

#### **EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:**

No amendment.

#### **BACKGROUND:**

Oregon is one of only five states that offers a veteran home loan program, separate from the federal VA Home Loan Guaranty, and administered by the Oregon Department of Veterans' Affairs (ODVA). Approximately \$8 billion in low-interest home loans has been made available to more than 334,000 veteran borrowers since 1945. ODVA conducted a comprehensive review of statutes governing home and farm loans to veterans, resulting in Senate Bill 36.
