
Emerging issues

- Continued funding for the Office of Outdoor Recreation


Parks and Recreation Revenue Sources

- Lottery Funds 15 percent of net lottery proceeds dedicated by Ballot Measure 76 (2010)




Parks and Recreation Expenditure History + 2019-21 Governor's Budget
