House Bill 2515

HB 2515 Seeks to:

- ✓ Require incarceration facilities to provide tampons and sanitary napkins to adult and juvenile female persons in custody at no charge, and to maintain a sufficient supply of these products;

OCDLA Recommends the Following Changes to HB 2515:

- ✓ The word “females” be changed to “persons” to ensure the new bill is trans-inclusive; and
- ✓ The phrase “sufficient supply” be defined to ensure that all persons in need have unlimited access to the *amount* and *type* of menstrual hygiene product for their specific needs.

OCDLA Supports HB 2515 Because:

- ✓ Incarcerated persons who menstruate are entitled to the basic sanitary necessities specific to their body’s needs, regardless of their ability to pay for them.
