The fee structure may or may not need to be changed, but allowing the Department of Agriculture to set “by rule” who pays the fee is a mistake.

It’s not the fee that is the problem here, it’s defining WHO pays “by rule”.

An “animal feed operation” could be just a kid’s 4-H project. A small family farm could be targeted “by rule” as large, whenever the department decides. And there is no long term clarity if a department can randomly decide to amend their “rule” to scoop up whoever they want, upgrade from small to large, with or without notice.

It’s not the fee that is the problem here, it’s defining who pays “by rule”.

Please abandon this house bill.
