WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Requires outfitters and guides to rent, sell or otherwise make available helmets to all passengers.

FISCAL: Minimal fiscal impact.

REVENUE: No revenue impact.

No amendment.

BACKGROUND:

Oregon law requires boat outfitters and guides to carry equipment such as first-aid, life jackets, light and smoke flares and running lights. "Outfitter and guide" as defined in ORS 704.010 include any person compensated for providing or offering outfitting and guiding services in this state or who hold federal special use permits for commercial outfitting and guiding.

House Bill 2652 would require outfitters and guides to rent, sell or otherwise make available helmets to all passengers.
