

Investments

- Capacity building grants to local governments and add one planner position (General Fund)
- Sage grouse implementation and coordination (General Fund)
- Add a planner position to implement updated Climate Change Adaptation Framework (Federal Funds)
- Add four planner positions to prepare natural hazard mitigation plans (Other Funds/Federal Funds)

Reductions

- Eliminates one planner position funded with General Fund
- General Fund reduction, holding some vacant positions unfilled longer
