**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:**

Requires that a commercial product that contains or is derived from cervid urine and that is designed for luring, attracting, or enticing cervid be from a herd tested for, and found free of, chronic wasting disease.

**EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:**

**BACKGROUND:**

Chronic wasting disease (CWD) is a fatal and contagious neurological disease that infects deer, elk, and moose populations. According to Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife, CWD has not yet been detected in Oregon cervids, but the introduction of the disease would cause a major impact to Oregon's economy.

House Bill 2294 would require that a commercial product that contains or is derived from cervid urine and that is designed for luring, attracting, or enticing cervid be from a herd tested for, and found free of, CWD.
