However, I believe that local voters, communities, and our local elected representatives must decide where more density is desirable, based on a thoughtful planning process that factors in affordability, traffic, transit, infrastructure, environmental consequences, and other local factors.
- These are issues that call for grassroots input from communities, not centralized boilerplate from Salem.
