Makes form and style edits to definitions used in visibility development requirements for subsidized rental housing.

1 A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to rental housing; amending ORS 456.508.
- 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
- 4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 456.508 is amended to read:
- 5 456.508. As used in ORS 456.510 and 456.513:
- 6 (1) "Accessible" means [that] housing that complies with federal accessi-
- 7 bility guidelines implementing the Fair Housing Amendments Act of 1988,
- 8 42 U.S.C. 3601 et seq., as amended and in effect on January 1, 2004.
- 9 (2) "Common living space" means a living [room,] **or** family room, dining 10 room or kitchen.
- 11 (3) "Contiguous units" means units that are on the same tax lot or on 12 contiguous tax lots [that] **and** have a common boundary. Tax lots that are
- 13 separated by a public road are contiguous tax lots for purposes of this sub-
- 14 section.

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- 15 (4) "New" means [that the] housing being constructed that did not previ-
- ously exist in residential or nonresidential form. "New" does not include the
- 17 acquisition, alteration, renovation or remodeling of an existing structure.
- 18 (5) "Powder room" means a room containing [at least] a toilet and sink.
- 19 (6) "Rental housing" means a dwelling unit designed for nonowner occu-20 pancy under a tenancy typically lasting six months or longer.
 - (7) "Subsidized development" means housing that receives [one or more of

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- 1 the following development subsidies] from the Housing and Community Ser-
- 2 vices Department:
- 3 (a) [The] A federal low-income housing tax credit under 26 U.S.C. 42(a),
- 4 if no part of the eligible basis prior to the application of 26 U.S.C. 42(i)(2)(B)
- 5 was financed with an obligation described in 26 U.S.C. 42(h)(4)(A), all as
- 6 amended and in effect on January 1, 2004;
- 7 (b) An agriculture workforce housing tax credit, as described in ORS 8 315.164;
- 9 (c) A loan that qualifies the lending institution for a subsidized housing loan tax credit, as described in ORS 317.097;
- 11 (d) Funding under the federal HOME Investment Partnerships Act, 42 12 U.S.C. 12721 to 12839, as amended and in effect on January 1, 2004;
- 13 (e) Moneys from the Oregon Housing Fund created under ORS 458.620; 14 or
- (f) Moneys from other grant or tax incentive programs administered by the [Housing and Community Services Department] department under ORS 456.559.
- 18 (8) "Visitable" means capable of being approached, entered and used by 19 individuals with mobility impairments[,] including [but not limited to] indi-20 viduals using wheelchairs.

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
