My name is Greg Delgado, and I am from Bend, Oregon. I am writing to urge your support for SB 608 and increased protection against unjust eviction and economic displacement for the 40% of Oregonians that rent their homes, including myself.

I have lived in my apartment in downtown Bend for nine years. I love my apartment, and the community I have been able to create around it. As a community leader, this space has provided a home for countless gatherings to prepare and plan for a wide range of community events from a Dia de Los Muertos celebration, to community meals, to political marches.

The rent continues to rise at a rate higher than I can keep up with and my landlord has hinted recently that I will be displaced soon. I will be removed from this neighborhood because the amount of available affordable housing is very scarce in this town.

I understand that sometimes the rent has to go up as inflation and other factors go up but how am I supposed to keep up if my income doesn't increase at the same rate. Please support SB 608, protect against some unfairness in our community and help us to maintain stability.
