WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Establishes Next Generation Educator Recruitment and Development Account for diversifying educator workforce for pre kindergarten through grade 12. Establishes grant limitations of \$5,000 per school district or education service district as grant participant; \$25,000 per early childhood program, institution of education, or non-profit as planning grant participant; \$500 per student awarded grant in high school and middle school. Allows State Board of Education to adopt rules to administer program. Establishes Educator Advancement Council with 13 members and defines membership. Allows applicant to match every \$3 grant awarded with \$1 local revenue. Establishes elements for grant program using grant funds. Appropriates \$16,700,000 out of the General Fund to ODE for the account establishment. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2019.
