WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Requires Oregon Department of Education (ODE) provide grants to enable school districts to provide at least one teacher for every 15 kindergarten students. Establishes requirements for qualifying schools. Requires qualifying schools have full day kindergarten program, ninety percent at free and reduced lunch, and establishing classroom capacity. Allows school districts to apply for one or more schools in the district. Appropriates money from the General Fund beginning July 1, 2019. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2019.

BACKGROUND:

Oregon does not currently provide grants to school districts to maintain student teacher ratios in kindergarten classes.
