Dear Senator Wagner and members of the Senate Education Committee and Sponsors, and the Oregon Senate:

I support the passage of SB 664, which would require all Oregon school districts to teach about the Holocaust and genocide. For more than 15 years, I have worked with Oregon middle and high school students to teach about the Holocaust. The issues that underpin the Holocaust continue to be a challenge in current times. I have seen first hand the impact that Holocaust education has on students, when they learn about the effects of discrimination and prejudice. This teaching cannot rest with a few speakers and the occasional opportunity for exposure to this topic. It needs to be presented in a systematic way through a school curriculum. The teaching is important not only from a historical perspective, but also in helping students be aware of how these lessons apply to their own lives, and to the future.
