WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Allows person issued disabled parking permit to park in parking space marked or signed by road authority as reserved for residents.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

No amendment.

BACKGROUND:

Current statute allows persons with disabilities under a disabled parking permit to park in a number of locations without incurring penalties to which the vehicle would otherwise be subject. Senate Bill 438 adds a parking space marked or signed by a road authority as reserved for residents to the list of places where a vehicle with a disabled parking permit can park without incurring penalty. A "road authority" is the body authorized to exercise authority over a road, highway, street, or alley.
