

HB 2612 STAFF MEASURE SUMMARY

WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Requires school district board prohibit school district from participating in voluntary organizations that administer interscholastic activities if the organizations schedule interscholastic activities on legal holidays or weekends preceding the holiday.

REVENUE: May have revenue impact, but no statement yet issued

FISCAL: May have fiscal impact, but no statement yet issued

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

No amendment.

BACKGROUND:

The Oregon School Activities Association is a voluntary organization that provides state coordination for the conduct of interscholastic activities. The organization works to promote interschool activities that provide equitable participation. Senate Bill 208-C (2017) clarified in law that charter school and homeschooled students in Oregon are eligible to participate in interscholastic activities.

HB 2612 would prohibit school districts from participating in voluntary organizations, such as the Oregon School Activities Association, if the organization schedules activities on legal holidays or weekends preceding such holidays.
