#### **SUMMARY**

Authorizes Oregon Board of Dentistry to review patient charts associated with dental pilot projects approved by Oregon Health Authority.

## 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to dental pilot projects; amending section 1, chapter 716, Oregon
- 3 Laws 2011.
- 4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
- 5 **SECTION 1.** Section 1, chapter 716, Oregon Laws 2011, is amended to 6 read:
- 7 Sec. 1. (1) The Oregon Health Authority may approve pilot projects to
- 8 encourage the development of innovative practices in oral health care deliv-
- 9 ery systems with a focus on providing care to populations that evidence-
- 10 based studies have shown have the highest disease rates and the least access
- 11 to dental care. The authority may approve a pilot project that is designed
- 12 to:
- 13 (a) Operate for three to five years or a sufficient amount of time to 14 evaluate the validity of the pilot project;
- (b) Evaluate quality of care, access, cost, workforce and efficacy; and
- 16 (c) Achieve at least one of the following:
- 17 (A) Teach new skills to existing categories of dental personnel;
- 18 (B) Develop new categories of dental personnel;
- 19 (C) Accelerate the training of existing categories of dental personnel; or
- 20 (D) Teach new oral health care roles to previously untrained persons.
- 21 (2) The authority shall adopt rules:

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- 1 (a) Establishing an application process for pilot projects;
- 2 (b) Establishing minimum standards, guidelines and instructions for pilot 3 projects; and
- 4 (c) Requiring an approved pilot project to report to the authority on the progress and outcomes of the pilot project, including:
- 6 (A) The process used to evaluate the progress and outcomes of the pilot 7 project;
- 8 (B) The baseline data and information to be collected;

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- 9 (C) The nature of program data that will be collected and the methods for collecting and analyzing the data;
- 11 (D) The provisions for protecting the safety of patients seen or treated in 12 the project; and
- 13 (E) A statement of previous experience in providing related health care 14 services.
- 15 (3) The authority shall seek the advice of appropriate professional socie-16 ties and licensing boards before adopting rules under subsection (2) of this 17 section.
  - (4) The Oregon Board of Dentistry may, as it determines necessary, review and provide clinical advice on patient charts that are associated with a pilot project approved by the authority under this section. The board shall consult with the authority regarding the board's review of the patient charts.
- [(4)(a)] (5)(a) Notwithstanding ORS 679.020 and 680.020, a person may practice dentistry or dental hygiene without a license as part of a pilot project approved under this section under the general supervision of a dentist licensed under ORS chapter 679 and in accordance with rules adopted by the authority.
- (b) A person practicing dentistry or dental hygiene without a license under this section is subject to the same standard of care and is entitled to the same immunities as a person performing the services with a license.
  - [(5)] (6) The authority may accept gifts, grants or contributions from any

- 2 received under this subsection shall be deposited in the Dental Pilot Projects
- 3 Fund established under section 17 [of this 2011 Act], chapter 716, Oregon
