A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to sentencing.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. The Oregon Criminal Justice Commission shall conduct a study on the relationship between recidivism rates and the length of prison sentences and present the results of the study, along with any recommended legislative changes, in a report to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to the judiciary in the manner provided under ORS 192.245 on or before September 15, 2020.

SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2019 Act is repealed on January 2, 2021.
